Speeding Concerns:

Often, the speeding that occurs in our neighborhood comes from our own residents. Speeding on our neighborhood streets have been evaluated multiple times by the City of Hagerstown, and unfortunately, we do not qualify for any sort of speed deterrents (i.e., speed humps). The speed data collected from the City and provided to the Board has been publishing on our website, as well as the City's traffic calming policy. The Board is researching other ways to have residents slow down on our community streets.

Please take this as a reminder to slow down on our streets and be courteous to others who live here too, especially those with young children.

Holiday Decorations

Seasonal decorations are approved two weeks prior to an event until two weeks after. Holiday lights which project decorations cannot be pointed at other neighbors' homes or directly into the sky; the decorations need to stay on your own home. Holiday lighting is pre-approved from Thanksgiving through January 15th. Violations will be issued if decorations are outside of this time frame.
