Just a reminder to store valuables out of sight in your car so nothing is visible. Lock your car whenever you exit. Report any suspicious activity to Hagerstown Police Department.

Suspicious activity includes:

- * Cars that are driving slowly and appear to be scouting the area
- * People loitering (especially around vehicles or behind properties)
- * Someone looking inside a vehicle or peering through home windows
- * Someone trying to enter a vehicle by unconventional means

Our community has been very pro-active about reporting unlawful activity and alerting other residents to potential

problems. These efforts may have prevented many residents from becoming victims of petty crimes.

A new school year has begun, which means you'll see a lot more buses on the road! When bus lights and stop signs are activated, vehicles must stop in both directions unless they are separated from the bus by a median. Please be attentive and watch for students as they walk to the bus stops in the mornings and afternoons.
